Looking for things to keep your children busy this summer? Then check out the Summer Fun Camp program at the Burleson Recreation Center (the BRiCk). There are 11 one-week sessions starting June 6. Camp time is 7 a.m.-6 p.m., Monday-Friday. The camps are geared toward children 6-12 years old.

Campers will participate in group games, arts and crafts, swimming, rock climbing, and team building events. They will also get to hear from some special guests.

Each week will include a one-day field trip. So far the list includes the Fort Worth Stockyards (June 6-10), Fort Worth Zoo (June 13-17), Splash Station Aquatics Center (June 27-July 1), Museum of Science and History (July 5-8), NRH20 (July 18-22), bowling (Aug. 1-5), Main Event (Aug. 8-12) and roller skating (Aug. 15-19).

The weekly fee for BRiCk members is \$115 for individuals and \$100 for any additional family member. Non-members pay \$130 for individuals and \$115 for any additional family member. The price is slightly lower during the July 5-8 camp since the Independence Day holiday makes it a four-day camp.

If you participate in the March 22 Open House at the BRiCk, you can get 10 percent off of the price of the weekly camps.
