The City is hosting a Household Hazardous Waste and Electronic Recycling event Saturday, May 14, 9 a.m.-11 a.m., at the City's old service center at 133 N. Main St.

Household hazardous waste items are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis until the Crud Cruiser is full. Only household hazardous waste from Burleson residents will be accepted. Bring a water or solid waste bill as proof of residency.

Burleson residency is not required for electronic recycling. Electronic material from homes and businesses will be accepted. E-Waste Collections is coordinating the electronic recycling. There will be a fee for TVs (\$10-\$30, depending on the size and if there is a wooden console); computer hard drive erasing, \$10; CRT computer monitors, \$5; and air conditioning unit Freon disposal, \$15. All other electronic items may be dropped off free of charge.

The Household Hazardous Waste collection is made possible thanks to the City of Burleson's contract with the City of Fort Worth's environmental management department, which owns and operates the Crud Cruiser and the Environmental Collection Center.
