City council will consider approving or denying a resolution tonight that supports the Texas Department of Transportation project to construct medians on Hwy. 174, from I-35W to John Jones Drive, in Burleson. The resolution is Item 4A on the Aug. 15 council agenda.

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is in the design stage of a construction project to add medians to Hwy. 174. Raised concrete medians would replace the center left turn lane. The project is scheduled for construction in 2012.

The City and TxDOT are hosting a public meeting on Tuesday, Sept. 27, 6 p.m.-8 p.m., at Burleson City Hall, 141 W. Renfro St. TxDOT will unveil the proposed design plans and listen to input from the public.

The median is fully funded by the Federal Highway Administration and TxDOT. Possible landscaping and irrigation of those medians would be funded by the City.
