Approximately 100 volunteers ventured down into drainage ditches and retail corridors after Friday night's rain to bash trash in the Sept. 17 Burleson Trash Bash.

Approximately 200 bags of trash for a grand total of 4,000 pounds of litter and debris were collected in just two hours. Volunteers were assigned to more than seven areas, including the I-35 frontage road; drainage ditches behind Home Depot and Target, Cici's Pizza and Army Navy, Hobby Lobby, Tractor Supply, and the BRiCk; and along Oak Valley Trail. The participants included individuals, families, three Girl Scout troops, one Cub Scout pack, two churches, four school clubs and the Mayor's Youth Council.

The City of Burleson and Keep Burleson Beautiful hosted the Burleson Trash Bash to clean up the trash and debris others leave behind. Following the cleanup, participants gathered at Warren Park for lunch and a prize ceremony. United Cooperative Services and Domino's pizza provided the pizza.
