Children have to send their parents to the Burleson Recreation Center (the BRiCk, 550 N.W. Summercrest Blvd.) or Burleson Public Library (248 S.W. Johnson Ave.) to make an appointment with the most famous North Pole resident. Informational fliers about the phone calls from the North Pole will also be distributed through the Burleson Independent School District's elementary campuses.

Santa's helpers will help St. Nick coordinate the phone calls, which will be made between 5:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m., Monday, Dec. 12, through Thursday, Dec. 15. These calls are geared toward children from pre-kindergarten through second grade. This is for Burleson residents and BISD students only.
