Two suspects are in custody following an aggravated robbery at a Burleson residence Thursday night that included an exchange of gunfire between the suspects and the homeowners.

DATE/TIME: Thursday, Feb. 16, 2012, 5:38 p.m.

LOCATION: 2100 block of S.W. Wilshire Blvd./Hwy. 174, Burleson

PARTICIPATING AGENCIES: Burleson Police Department, Johnson County Sheriff's Office, Joshua Police Department, Johnson County Pct. 2 Constable's Office and Cleburne Police Department

SUSPECTS

- A 46-year-old Fort Worth man: Aggravated robbery and felon in possession of a firearm
- A 48-year-old Burleson man: Aggravated robbery

Burleson police officers responded to an aggravated robbery with shots fired. The two suspects fled the scene, southbound on Hwy. 174 toward Joshua, in an older model white Honda.

A Joshua officer found a vehicle matching the description on Hwy. 174 and attempted to stop it. The driver of the suspect vehicle attempted to flee. The suspect vehicle was stopped and the two suspects were taken into custody.

According to the Burleson officers, the homeowners arrived home to find the two suspects allegedly burglarizing the home. The suspects attempted to flee. Shots were fired. This part of the incident is still under investigation so no more information is being released at this time.

No one was injured the Feb.16 incident.
