Guess who's coming to town?

The big guy from the North Pole is hosting the City's 16th annual Breakfast with Santa on Saturday, Dec. 5, 7 a.m.-11 a.m., at the BRiCk. The event is geared to children from birth to 12 years old (children 2 and younger get in free).

Saint Nick's elves will be up before the crack of dawn flipping pancakes, cooking sausage, and serving the orange juice and coffee. Santa will be in the BRiCk's Winter Wonderland until 11 a.m. to hear Christmas wishes, so bring your camera, and then stop by Santa's workshop to make holiday crafts.

Admission is \$4 for children and \$5 for adults if you buy the tickets in advance. On the day of the event, Breakfast with Santa tickets are \$5 for children and \$7 for adults. Tickets are on sale at the BRiCk (Burleson Recreation Center) now. The BRiCk is located at 550 N.W. Summercrest Blvd.

Breakfast isn't the only Christmas festivity on Dec. 5. There's going to be a parade, tree lighting and fireworks!

The Burleson Rotary Club is hosting the Parade of Lights that steps off from Kerr Middle School at 6 p.m. Entry fees range from \$10-\$45. Santa will be on that last Parade of Lights float.

Santa Claus' final Burleson stop on Dec. 5 is the corner of Johnson Avenue and Ellison Street, which will be bustling with dancers and singers entertaining the parade crowd. Santa and his helpers have the honors of turning on the lights on the City tree, followed by the fireworks show, which is choreographed to holiday music. The fireworks show is a 10-15 minute low-aerial show at the corner of Johnson Avenue and Ellison Street.
