Three suspects arrested for shooting death

Three suspects have been arrested for the Sept. 21, 2020 shooting death of Shaunathan Elijah Hunt McMahon, 17-year-old male, from Burleson.

Burleson PD arrested Xavier Miranda, 18, and Bryan Dominguez, 17, both of Burleson on Sept. 24. They have since been booked into Mansfield Law Enforcement Center on Murder charges. A third suspect, Michael Elian Ulloa, 18-year-old male, of Fort Worth was placed in custody on Friday, Sept. 25. Ulloa is charged with Tampering with Physical Evidence and was transported to Johnson County Law Enforcement Center.

Mr. McMahon was shot when the suspects met the victim to sell him illegal narcotics. During the drug transaction, one of the suspects believed money provided by the victim was counterfeit. When confronted, the victim fled from the vehicle and one of the suspects fired at the victim, striking him in the back. McMahon was transported to Texas Health Huguley Hospital, 11801 South Freeway, Fort Worth, where he was pronounced deceased at 12:11 a.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 22.

The incident occurred at Alsbury Villas, 755 NE Alsbury Blvd., neither the victim nor suspects resided at that location.
