2020 Election & Voting Information

Due to public health and safety concerns related to COVID-19 the May 2, 2020 City of Burleson General Election was postponed to November 3, 2020 for the offices of: Mayor, Councilmember Place 2, Councilmember Place 4, Councilmember Place 6.

The candidates are as follows: Mayor - Chris Fletcher and Ken Shetter; Place 2 - Rick Green, unopposed; Place 4 - Todd K. Hulse and Tamara Payne; Place 6 - Ronnie Johnson, unopposed.

Voting Locations: depends on the county you live in.

Johnson County voters

Early Voting: Burleson Sub-Courthouse, 247 Elk Dr, , Room 104, Burleson
Election Day Voting: all voting is at your precinct only

What do I need to bring with me to vote in any Texas election including city?

You are required to produce a photo id to vote, there are seven accepted forms:

1. Texas Driver's License
2. Texas Election ID
3. Texas Personal ID
4. Texas Handgun License
5. US Military ID
6. US passport

All must be original not a copy – may not be expired more than 4 years

7. US Citizen Certificate

Must be original not a copy – Cannot be expired must be current

What if I want to vote by mail? What are the qualifications to vote by mail?

You must submit an application for a ballot by mail to the county by October 23, 2020

- Know your county – Johnson or Tarrant
 - Johnson county
Early Voting Clerk, Patty Bourgeois, Johnson County Election Administrator, PO Box 895, Cleburne, TX 76033
 - Tarrant County
Early Voting Clerk, Heider I. Garcia, Tarrant County Election Administrator, PO Box 961011, Fort Worth, TX 76161-0011

Qualifications to vote by mail:

- Be 65 years or older
- Be sick or disabled
- Be out of the county on election day and during the period for early voting by personal appearance
- Be confined in jail but otherwise eligible
