

10 Frequently Asked Questions About BRiCK Natatorium Pool Party Rentals

1. What exactly does the rental fee cover?

The fee covers the use of the associated party room, its amenities and pool usage for your guests. One party room entitles you to up to, but no more than, 25 guests. Two party rooms allow you to have a total number of 50 guests.

2. What is the maximum amount of guests per room? Do you count adults as well as children as guests?

If so, is everyone (adults/children) allowed to swim? The maximum amount of guests per party room is 25. Adults, children and infants are all counted in that number, as patron load must be compliant with our fire code. Yes, all guests are welcome to swim, however those who elect not to swim are still counted as part of the guest list.

3. Can the room be rented for just an hour or do you have a minimum of 2 hours?

There is a minimum rental time of 2 HRS.

4. Will I be allowed extra time to set up and decorate before the party starts?

No. Set up and clean up time is included in your rental time. So if your rental time is 1PM, you cannot start setting up until 1PM. If your ending time is 3PM, everything must be cleaned and ready for the next party to begin by 3PM. If you desire extra time to set up and/or clean up and do not want your guests arriving as you're decorating, it is a good idea to add extra time in the rental for those purposes.

5. What type of decorations can be used?

Decorations must be appropriate and not require any damaging application to our walls, floors, tables or chairs. We allow balloons, but only if they are kept strictly in the party rooms. In the event one pops, it is imperative the pieces are picked up and discarded immediately, as they are a choking hazard.

6. We are planning on bringing in food/drinks. Are there electrical plugs to use for crock pots or serving dishes?

Sure, there are electrical outlets, a counter, tables, chairs and a sink in each of the rooms. Note that food and drinks are permitted in the party rooms only. Food is prohibited on the deck or in the water.

7. How do most renters set up their parties? Am I required to do the food, cake and ice cream portion of the party at the beginning of the rental time?

How you choose to organize your party is totally up to you. It is helpful to know ahead of time that the last ten minutes of every hour in the Natatorium is Break Time, everyone under the age of 18 must exit the pool for 10 minutes. (This encourages children to use our restrooms,

rehydrate, etc.) Many renters utilize the first hour's break time as snack/cake time, so the children will be occupied during the 10 minute break.

8. Can my guests can stay and swim after the party is over until open swim time is over?

Your guests are free to stay and swim in the pool after the party is over; however, this is not included with your purchase of a pool party. You just have to have the room clean, all trash taken out to the dumpster (the renter is responsible for their trash, not the water safety staff) and vacated by the end of your rental time.

9. What are the times available for parties on the weekend?

We have two options for type of Natatorium rentals: During Normal Business Hours and After Hours.

- If you choose to rent the pool during normal business hours, the rooms are available any time our Natatorium is open for Open Swim.
- If you plan on having more than 50 people attend the party or just prefer to have a private party where only your guests are using the facility, rental opportunities are Fridays 7:45pm to 9:45pm, Saturdays 7:45pm to 9:45pm and Sundays 5:45pm to 7:45pm or 7:45pm to 9:45pm.
- It's important to note that when you choose to host a private party, there are two options: Indoor Private Party with Slide or Indoor Private Party without Slide.

10. How soon do I need to reserve the time for the party?

The sooner, the better. We operate on a first-come, first-serve basis. You may call 817-426-9106 to check on date and time availability but the only way to secure your date and time is to fill out and submit a rental request form and put down your \$75 deposit here at the BRiCk.
