



BURLESON BARK PARK RULES



- Please read and understand all rules before entering.
 - Failure to comply with rules may result in a fine up to \$2000.
 - Please be advised that the surface of the dog park may present hazards, including dog waste, parasites, and other contaminants.
 - Park users and dog owners assume all risk related to dog park use.
 - All general park rules and city ordinances must be obeyed.

GENERAL RULES

- NOT ALLOWED
 - More than 3 dogs per owner
 - Known aggressive dogs
 - Dogs in heat
- Please keep dogs on a leash until inside designated off-leash area
- Dispose of pet waste and trash in a trash receptacle
- It is recommended that children under the age of 12 not enter large dog area. If they choose to enter, they must be accompanied by an adult.
- Any scratch or bite to a person must be reported to Burleson Animal Services, 817-426-9283. For medical emergencies, dial 9-1-1.
- All dogs must display current rabies tag on collar
- Do not allow dogs to dig holes in soil
- No smoking allowed, including e-cigs
- No glass bottles allowed in city parks

OFF-LEASH AREA RULES

- No food for humans or dogs allowed, including dog treats
- Spike, prong and pinch collars must be removed
- All dogs must remain under visual and voice control of owner at all times and may not be left unattended
- No puppies under the age of 4 months are allowed in off-leash area
- Dogs must be removed immediately at first sign of aggression
