



GENERAL AQUATICS FACILITY RULES

(Applies to all aquatic areas unless otherwise noted)

- Walk at all times; running is not permitted
- Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated
- Follow all posted rules and staff instructions at all times
- Failure to follow rules or staff direction may result in removal from the facility
- Dispose of all trash in designated receptacles
- No glass containers
- No tobacco products, vaping, or electronic cigarettes
- No alcohol
- Animals are not permitted, except service animals (service animals allowed on deck only, not in the water)
- Patrons must shower before entering any pool
- Do not swim if you have been ill with diarrhea within the past two weeks
- Extended breath-holding activities are prohibited
- Diaper changing is prohibited within 6 feet of any pool or splash feature

SUPERVISION & AGE REQUIREMENTS

- Children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by a parent or responsible person in a swimsuit at all times, including in the water, on deck, and in restrooms
- Supervising adults must remain within arm's reach of children when required
- Adult supervision is strongly recommended for children under the age of 12
- During designated break times, all patrons under 18 must exit the water

SWIM ATTIRE & HYGIENE

- Proper swim attire is required at all times
- Swim shirts or rash guards are permitted **only where specifically allowed**
- Cut-off shorts, underwear, or undergarments are not permitted
- Infants and toddlers must wear a swim diaper covered by an appropriate swimsuit
- Monofins and mermaid tails are prohibited

FLOTATION & SAFETY DEVICES

- Inflatable floats and water wings are not permitted
- Only Coast Guard–approved flotation devices and lifejackets are allowed
- Lifejackets are available for use at designated locations
- Swimmers requiring flotation devices may not enter water deeper than 3 feet unless accompanied by a capable adult swimmer

INDOOR POOL RULES

- No diving, back dives, flips, or unsafe activities
- Do not hang on lane ropes
- No unnecessary interaction with lifeguards or pool safety staff
- Last 10 minutes of every hour is designated break time for patrons under 18

OUTDOOR POOL RULES

- All patrons entering the outdoor pool area must pay the required admission fee
- No diving in water less than 5 feet deep
- No cannonballs, flips, or unsafe entry from the pool edge
- Diving board rules apply where posted:
 - One person on the board at a time
 - Exit the diving area immediately after use
 - No shirts, rash guards, goggles, or glasses on the diving board
- Staff reserves the right to implement additional rules for safety and comfort

SLIDE TOWER & WATER SLIDE RULES

- Riders must be at least **48 inches tall**
- Maximum rider weight: **300 lbs**
- One rider at a time; no riding with another person
- Feet first, on back only; hands and feet must remain inside the slide
- No stopping, standing, kneeling, or rotating in the slide
- No jewelry, goggles, glasses, or loose objects
- No shirts, tank tops, rash guards, or swim shirts
- No lifejackets or puddle jumpers
- Non-swimmers are not permitted
- Follow dispatcher instructions at all times
- Exit the receiving pool immediately after riding
- Only 8 people permitted on the slide tower at one time
- Pregnant patrons or those with heart or major health conditions should not ride without physician approval
- **Warning: Water depth is 3 feet 6 inches**

SPLASH PAD RULES

- No attendant on duty — use at your own risk
- All park rules apply
- Do not run
- No bathing or drinking water from splash features
- Do not sit on ground sprays or features; injury may occur
- Water shoes are recommended
- No pets
- No bikes, skateboards, rollerblades, or similar devices
- No glass containers

- No water balloons
- Children in diapers must wear swim diapers
- Splash pad will close during inclement weather
